HISTORY



Locating the Johnson Space Center in Clear Lake City brought many government employees and contractors to this area in the early 1960's. As a result, many residential developments started to accommodate the influx, including Sagemont, in 1964. The number of Catholics settling in Sagemont swelled the congregation of St. Frances Cabrini located across Interstate 45. It grew steadily for ten years and new parishioners, anxious to become an active part of the parish community, offered their talents and education to parish service.

The rapid growth made it obvious that it would soon be necessary to create a new parish to serve the Catholics living west of I-45. The diocese purchased five acres of land in Kirkwood South in anticipation of the split. The pastor and parish council at St. Frances (1,800 registered parishioners strong and finding it increasingly difficult to adequately minister to the needs of so many) then began planning the division. Even before boundaries were drawn and a pastor was assigned, a Parish Split Committee was appointed from the parish council membership at St. Frances Cabrini and instructed to formulate plans for a smooth transition with minimum disruptive effects for all concerned.

On April 3, 1975, ten weeks before the division, the committee presented recommendations for the split. They included providing the new pastor (not yet named) with census cards, CCE student records and teacher education cards for those in the parish boundaries. They also proposed setting aside collection envelopes from those parishioners for four weeks prior to split date, sharing the Saturday evening liturgy collection. To spare the new parish additional rent expense, the committee proposed offering the use of facilities at St. Frances for baptisms, weddings, funerals, and CCE classrooms, as well as miscellaneous equipment when available.

Within the next few weeks, Reverend Jesse Judge was appointed pastor of the new parish. He asked those on the St. Frances Cabrini Parish Council who should be in the new parish to serve on an interim parish council. Meetings were held on May 29, and June 12, where decisions on purchasing a rectory, acquiring facilities at Thompson Intermediate School for Sunday liturgies and CCE classes, setting mass times, hiring a religious education coordinator, and appointing a Finance Council chairperson were made.

On June 17, 1975, at 7:00 pm, over 500 families who had been determined to live within the boundaries of the new parish were invited to celebrate Mass and attend a "birthday party" at St. Frances Cabrini. At the party, all were given the opportunity to indicate their area of interest for participation in the new parish, and St. Luke the Evangelist Catholic Church was born.

HISTORIA



La ubicación del Centro Espacial Johnson en Clear Lake City trajo a muchos empleados gubernamentales y contratistas a esta área a principios de la década de 1960. Como resultado, muchos desarrollos residenciales comenzaron a acomodar la afluencia, incluido Sagemont, en 1964. El número de católicos que se establecieron en Sagemont aumentó la congregación de St. Frances Cabrini ubicada en la Interestatal 45. Creció constantemente durante diez años y nuevos feligreses, ansiosos para convertirse en una parte activa de la comunidad parroquial, ofreció sus talentos y educación al servicio parroquial.

El rápido crecimiento hizo obvio que pronto sería necesario crear una nueva parroquia para servir a los católicos que viven al oeste de la I-45. La diócesis compró cinco acres de tierra en Kirkwood South en previsión de la división. El Pastor y el consejo parroquial en St. Frances (1,800 feligreses registrados fuertes y cada vez más difícil ministrar adecuadamente a las necesidades de tantos) luego comenzaron a planificar la división. Incluso antes de que se establecieran los límites y se asignara un Pastor, se nombró un Comité parroquial dividido entre los miembros del consejo parroquial en St. Frances Cabrini e instruido para formular planes para una transición sin problemas con efectos disruptivos mínimos para todos los interesados.

El 3 de abril de 1975, diez semanas antes de la división, el comité presentó recomendaciones para la división. Incluyeron proporcionar al nuevo Pastor (aún no nombrado) tarjetas de censo, registros de estudiantes de CCE y tarjetas de educación de maestros para los que están en los límites de la parroquia. También propusieron dejar a un lado los sobres de colección de esos feligreses durante cuatro semanas antes de la fecha de división, compartiendo la colección de liturgia del sábado por la noche. Para evitar el gasto de alquiler adicional de la nueva parroquia, el comité propuso ofrecer el uso de instalaciones en St. Frances para bautizos, bodas, funerales y aulas de CCE, así como equipos varios cuando estén disponibles.

En las próximas semanas, el reverendo Jesse Judice fue nombrado Pastor de la nueva parroquia. Preguntó a los miembros del Consejo Parroquial de St. Frances Cabrini quién debería estar en la nueva parroquia para servir en un consejo parroquial interino. Las reuniones se llevaron a cabo el 29 de mayo y el 12 de junio, donde se tomaron decisiones sobre la compra de una rectoría, la adquisición de instalaciones en la Escuela Intermedia Thompson para liturgias dominicales y clases de CCE, el establecimiento de horarios masivos, la contratación de un coordinador de educación religiosa y el nombramiento de un presidente del Consejo de Finanzas.

El 17 de junio de 1975, a las 7:00 pm, más de 500 familias que habían sido determinadas a vivir dentro de los límites de la nueva parroquia fueron invitadas a celebrar la misa y asistir a una "fiesta de cumpleaños" en St. Frances Cabrini. En la fiesta, todos tuvieron la oportunidad de indicar su área de interés para participar en la nueva parroquia, y nació la Iglesia Católica San Lucas Evangelista.

MARRIAGE / CONVALIDATION PROGRAM

Couples preparing for the Sacrament of Marriage at St. Luke can visit our website www.stlukescatholic.com/marriagematrimonio to register for Marriage Preparation classes. Once registered, a member of our marriage preparation team will contact you. Preparation for Marriage involves classes and meetings with a member of the clergy and typically takes at least six months to complete. Once the necessary classes are fulfilled and all paperwork is in order, a member of the clergy will contact you to schedule a wedding date. After a wedding date is scheduled the hall can be scheduled.



Similar to our marriage preparation program, a *convalidation* is the process by which a couple who has been married outside the Catholic Church – such as before a judge or in another denomination – brings their marriage into the Catholic Church. This is sometimes referred to as having the marriage “blessed.” We look forward to welcoming these couples back.

BAPTISM CLASSES FOR PARENTS/GODPARENTS - *For Infant Baptisms up to age 6*

HIGH SCHOOL FAITH FORMATION

The primary gathering for High School Faith Formation is Life Teen. See *Youth Ministry* for more information.

FIRST SACRAMENTS

Youth First Sacraments sessions are extra, separate and distinct from the regular Faith Formation Program (CCFF). Attendance to both programs is required. Typically, the Sacramental Preparation sessions for Youth First Sacraments sessions occur for six - seven Saturdays in the Fall (1st Reconciliation) and six - seven Saturdays in the Spring (1st Eucharist). Students MUST ATTEND both Reconciliation & Eucharist sessions.

YOUTH CONFIRMATION Typically, the Sacramental Preparation Classes for Youth Confirmation occur for about seven to eight sessions from April - October with an additional day of reflection.

- A three-day mandatory summer retreat occurs in June.
- Obligatory group service day is scheduled for either June, July or August.
- A night of reflection and a reconciliation service occur in the fall before the Rite of Confirmation.



The Youth Confirmation sessions are extra, separate and distinct from regular High School Faith Formation offered on Sundays or Catholic HS Religion classes. Attendance to all programs is required.

BECOMING CATHOLIC (OCIC) - *For children/youth ages 7 to 17 (or 18 if in High School)* OCIC (Order of Christian Initiation of Children) is intended for children, not baptized as infants or who are baptized but have not received any formal catechesis, who have attained the use of reason and are of catechetical age. In a spirit of reverence, Eucharistic Ministers share the Body and Blood of Christ with the Assembly. Must be a fully initiated Catholic (Baptized and Confirmed). If married, must be recognized by the Church. Living a life in good standing with the Church.

SACRISTAN

The sacristan carefully arranges the liturgical books, the vestments, and other things necessary in the celebration of the Mass as well as directs the EMHC during Communion at Mass. Must have prior experience as an EMHC.

ALTAR SERVER

Other than priests and deacons, no one else is allowed to so closely play a part in the preparation of the Eucharist. Your participation as an Altar Server is special. When you serve the priests and deacons, you serve the people of God, and above all, you serve Christ. Server must be at least 10 years old & have received their First Communion.

MUSIC MINSTRY

We have many opportunities including adult, youth and children's choirs and orchestra. Musicians are needed year-round.
